## Training Policies & Procedures

Region 9 Child Care Resource and Referral Service is committed to providing high quality workshops to assist child care professionals in meeting state requirements. We hope you will find our workshops useful and interesting, and we always welcome your suggestions.

Workshop calendars are mailed to child care professionals bi-annually. All workshops are approved by the North Carolina Division of Child Development and Early Education and qualify for in-service hours. The calendar can be found on our Region 9 website at [www.region9ccrr.org](http://www.region9ccrr.org) by clicking on Caldwell County.

Registration forms are only accepted with payment, either through the mail or in person. No registration forms will be accepted via fax, e-mail, or any other method than what is listed above. All fees must be paid in cash, check, or money order payable to the Iredell County Partnership for Young Children (ICPYC). There will be a return check fee for any check that is returned for insufficient funds to the Iredell County Partnership for Young Children. Anyone with a returned check will not be able to register for workshops until all fees are paid in full.

Participants who are unable to attend a workshop are required to give a 24-hour notice of cancellation in order to receive a credit transferable to another workshop. Substitutions are allowed. Participants arriving 15 minutes late, can stay for the workshop but will not receive workshop credit.

Disruptive and/or rude behavior of any participant will be addressed with the individual, as well as the director of the child care facility they represent. (Examples: talking, cell phone usage, etc.) If the behavior continues, the participant will be asked to leave and will not receive any workshop credit. Please make prior arrangements for child care, as young children are not allowed at any of the workshop sessions.

## Infant-Toddler Educator AWARDS\$

Infant-Toddler Educator AWARD\$ is a new statewide salary supplement program designed to better compensate and retain well-educated teachers working with our youngest children.

To be eligible for AWARD\$, applicants must:

1. Work at least 35 hours per week with infants, ones or twos.
2. Earn at or below \$18 per hour. Bonuses from the employer will be included in calculations to determine hourly rate.
3. Work in a licensed child care program with at least three stars.
4. Have an Associates Degree in Early Childhood Education or higher.
